In this manual is explained how a Nokia 6310i can communicate with de Nokia Suite by using a Conceptronic Bluetooth adapter like the CBTU and CBT100U

Requirements

Hardware:

• A Conceptronic Bluetooth adapter like the CBTU and CBT100U

Software:

- Windows XP
- Latest driver from website for the Bluetooth adapter (We have been tested with ver. 1.4.7)
- Latest version from Nokia Suite (We have been tested with ver. 4.88)

Installation

If the Conceptronic Bluetooth adapter and Nokia Suite are not installed, install them now first. Also must be Bluetooth enabled on the phone.



Double click "My Bluetooth Places"



Click "View devices in range"



After a while you see a phone with the name "**Nokia 6310i**" if you use the default name. Double click the phone pictogram.
