

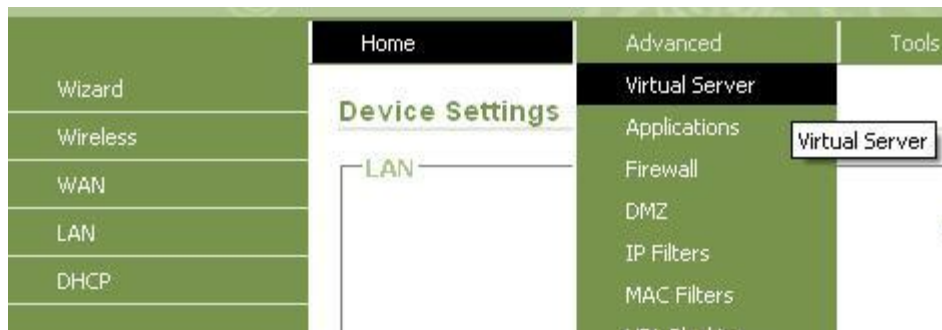
C54BRS4A: Open Ports



Access router configuration opening web browser and enter router IP address (by default: 192.168.0.1). When you are at initial page you must enter username and password to be able to change configuration parameters.

(by default: username: *admin* / password: *admin*).

At main menu we will choose Virtual Server option that can be found in Advanced tab.



First thing what you get is a list of open port rules. If you haven't created any rule then will be empty.

Below you can see configuration field necessities to open ports:

Virtual Server: With this option we can activate rule.

Name: Here we can set a rule name (for instance EMULE).

Private IP address: Add here IP address where rule will be applied.

Protocol: Select protocol port, TCP, UDP or both.

Private port: Select port that you want open.

Public port: Add again port you want to open.

Shedule: Leave it as is (Always).

When all parameters are configured then press "Apply" button and wait until router is restarted.
